RESOLUTION NO. 15-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO, TO SUBMIT A REQUEST TO THE TAX COMMISSIONER OF THE STATE OF OHIO TO TRANSFER ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$150.50) FROM THE MAYOR'S COURT COMPUTER FUND (2901) TO THE GENERAL FUND (1000) AND CLOSING THE MAYOR'S COURT COMPUTER FUND (2901) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Perry Council established the Mayor's Court on May 30, 1979; and,

WHEREAS, funds were deposited into Fund 2901 for the purposes described in ORC 1901.261; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Perry Mayor's Court was closed in 2019; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it in the best interests of the residents of the Village to transfer the funds held in "2901 Mayor's Court Computer Fund" to the General Fund (1000); and

WHEREAS, at the advice of the Ohio Auditor of State's Office requests the approval of the Tax Commissioner of Ohio pursuant to ORC 5705.16 to transfer said funds and subsequently close Fund 2901.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Fiscal Officer of the Village is hereby authorized and directed to submit Form FTR-1, a one page form, Exhibit A, included herein by reference, to the Tax Commissioner of Ohio, requesting the approval of the transfer, of the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$150.50) from the Mayor's Court Computer Fund (2901) to the Village's General Fund (1000).

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Fiscal Officer of the Village is authorized to complete send transfer if approval is received from the Tax Commissioner.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Fiscal Officer of the Village is authorized to close Mayor's Court Computer Fund 2901 after said transfer is completed.

Section 4. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 5.</u> That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to insure the proper administration of Village financial affairs. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

Re: Approval of a Transfer of Funds for the Village of Perry, Lake County, Ohio from the Mayor's Court Computer Fund (2901) to the General Fund (1000)

The Village of Perry filed an application on April 11, 2025, with the Tax Commissioner for authority to transfer funds from the Mayor's Court Computer Fund (2901) to the General Fund (1000) pursuant to R.C. 5705.15 and 5705.16. The amount requested to be transferred is One Hundred Fifty Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$150.50). The source of money in the Mayor's Court Fund is Computer fees pursuant to ORC 1901.261. Based upon a review of all available documents, there are no restrictions on this transfer of funds.

This fund transfer meets the three-factor test of R.C. 5705.16 in that the petition states sufficient facts, there are good reasons for the transfer, and no injury will result from the transfer.
