

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 25-2025**

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES NATUREWORKS GRANT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks grant program and

WHEREAS, the Village, if successful in its grant application, will abide by all required policies; and

WHEREAS, it is accordingly the desire of this Council to authorize the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to make application for said funding, and to authorize the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to accept the funding if awarded and to execute a contract for the same;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Perry, County of Lake, State of Ohio,

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Village Council approves filing this application for financial assistance.

That the Fiscal Officer and Mayor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

That the Village of Perry does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Grant Program.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this Council does further authorize the Mayor and Fiscal Officer to accept any funding that they may be awarded by and through the ODNR NatureWorks Grant application.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the efficient administration of Village affairs, and for the immediate

preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and upon its passage by the members of Council and approval of the Mayor, shall go into effect at the earliest period allowable by law.

### NATUREWORKS 31st ROUND APPLICATION



## All applications must be <u>postmarked</u> by JUNE 2, 2025. There are no exceptions.

NatureWorks is a State funded grant program that provides up to 75 percent of project cost assistance to Ohio municipalities, counties, townships, joint recreation districts, park districts and conservancy districts for acquisition or development of public outdoor recreation areas. All grant payments are made on a reimbursement basis; project sponsors must have adequate funds to finance the grant project prior to receiving reimbursement.

- The NatureWorks application *postmark* deadline is June 2, 2025.
- The proposed project scope must be either development or acquisition, not both.
- Only one park per application please.
- County funding allocations for Nature Works Round 31 are listed on page 35. You may apply for any amount up to the maximum amount for your county (county location of proposed project). If your County allocation is greater than \$150,000 the maximum amount granted will be capped at \$150,000.
- NatureWorks recommendation announcements are planned for November 2025. Various factors can cause delays. Please check the ODNR website <a href="https://ohiodnr.gov/natureworks">https://ohiodnr.gov/natureworks</a> for updates.
- Mail one paper copy of your application to ODNR by June 2, 2025 (postmark deadline). We recommend applications be mailed with a return/tracking receipt. **Do not** submit applications in metal ring binders. Please keep a copy of your completed application for your records.

Issue 1 "AUTHORIZED THE STATE OF OHIO TO ISSUE BONDS, WHICH WILL BE RETIRED FROM GENERAL STATE REVENUES, TO FINANCE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR STATE AND LOCAL PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS AND TO PRESERVE OHIO'S NATURAL AREAS AND HABITATS..." and ... "PERMITS THE STATE TO MAKE GRANTS AND ASSIST LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WITH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS RELATED TO NATURAL RESOURCES. . .
