

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-03

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE
APPOINTMENT OF STEVEN WILLIAMS AS STREET COMMISSIONER
ROAD SUPERVISOR OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, OHIO,
PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 735.31
OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Mayor of the Village of Perry, Ohio, has recommended the appointment of Steven Williams to the position of Street Commissioner/Road Supervisor of the Village for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has further advised Council that Steven Williams possesses the knowledge, skill, experience and professionalism that, together with his sincere personal concern for the well-being of the residents of our Village, is necessary to insure the appropriate administration of the village's Road Department and Maintenance Department; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has also recommended that the residency requirement set forth in Section 735.31 of the Ohio Revised Code be waived in accordance with the provisions of said Section; and

WHEREAS, Council that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Village to confirm and approve the recommendation of Steven Williams to the position of Street Commissioner/Road Supervisor of the Village of Perry.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, upon the recommendation of the Mayor, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 735.31 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Council of the Village of Perry, Ohio, hereby consents, confirms, authorizes and approves the appointment of Steven Williams to the position of Street Commissioner/Road Supervisor of the Village of Perry, Lake County, Ohio, in accordance with the terms, provisions and conditions set forth in the Agreement that is attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof.


Section 2. That said Street Commissioner/Road Supervisor shall be paid annual compensation at the rate of together with all other benefits attendant to said position.

Section 3. That the requirement contained in Section 735.31 of the Ohio Revised Code that the Street Commissioner become a resident of the Village within six (6) months after his appointment by the Mayor and confirmation by the legislative authority is hereby waived.

Section 4. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need for the efficient administration of Village affairs. Said Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry, Ohio.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
