

RESOLUTION NO. 56-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DENTAL AND VISION
CARE PROVIDER OFFERING THE BEST AND
MOST REASONABLE RATES THROUGH ACRISURE
FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 2026
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has been advised that there is an immediate need to provide for the continuation of dental and vision care insurance coverage and benefits for certain employees of the Village of Perry; and,

WHEREAS, Council deems it to be in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Perry to provide for the uninterrupted continuation of said dental and vision care benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with The dental and vision care provider he determines to be offering the best and most reasonable rates as provided by Acrisure (formerly Burnham Flowers Agency) for the purpose of securing continuous and uninterrupted dental and vision care insurance coverage and benefits for certain employees of the Village, as is more specifically set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to continually provide for the fair and proper administration of Village affairs and protect the health and safety of Village residents. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Perry, Ohio.

Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
