**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER
INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LAKE COUNTY AUTOMATIC DATA
PROCESSING BOARD FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Perry currently operates its own network infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Automatic Data Processing Board (the "Board") currently operates a network infrastructure for use by Lake County and integrated with other political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 307.846 permits a county automatic data processing board to enter into a contract with the legislative authority of a Village to provide automatic or electronic data processing or record-keeping services; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to enter into an agreement with the Board for said Information Technology Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Perry, Lake County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement for Information Technology Services with the Lake County Automatic Data Processing Board. The terms and conditions of said Agreement shall be substantially similar to those set forth in the "Agreement for Information Technology Services," attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.

**AGREEMENT FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
SERVICES BY AND BETWEEN
LAKE COUNTY AUTOMATIC DATA PROCESSING BOARD
AND VILLAGE OF PERRY**

This AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the Lake County Automatic Data Processing Board ("COUNTY"), with its principal place of business at 105 Main Street, Painesville, Ohio 44077, and VILLAGE OF PERRY ("Village"), a political subdivision, with its principal place of business at 3758 Center Rd., Perry, OH 44081

WHEREAS, the Village currently operates its own network infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY currently operates a network infrastructure for use by the COUNTY and integrated with other political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, RC. 307.846 permits a county automatic data processing board to enter into a contract with the legislative authority of a Village to provide automatic or electronic data processing or record-keeping services; and

WHEREAS, the Village seeks to receive the services of the COUNTY for automatic or electronic data processing or record-keeping.

NOW THEREFORE, for valuable consideration given, the parties mutually agree and covenant as follows:

SECTION 1: SCOPE OF SERVICES

- 1.1 COUNTY shall provide supervisory and technical staff as it deems necessary for the satisfactory performance of the work described in this AGREEMENT. Such staff will be provided by COUNTY through its Information Technology Department ("IT").
- 1.2 COUNTY shall integrate the Village's current network infrastructure, servers, and computers into the COUNTY's network. The Village shall implement the measures recommended by the COUNTY to facilitate the integration process.
- 1.3 Throughout the course of this agreement, COUNTY shall provide the following:
 - 1.3.1 Technical assistance to the Village for support and maintenance of the Village's computers, hardware, software and networking infrastructure.
 - 1.3.2 Documentation of all time spent on services provided in this

AGREEMENT.

- 1.3.3 Any services set forth in the Scope of Work letters, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 1.3.4 Such additional services not specifically described in this AGREEMENT as are mutually agreed-to in writing by both parties. Such written agreement shall be deemed to be an amendment to this AGREEMENT as described in Section 6.

SECTION 2- EQUIPMENT

- 2.1 The Village bears the sole responsibility for the purchase of equipment necessary to accomplish any item within the Scope of Services.
- 2.2. The Village may consult with IT to determine the best equipment to accomplish various tasks, but IT shall, in any event, determine the minimum standards of equipment necessary to accomplish any item within the Scope of Services.

SECTION 3- PAYMENT

- 1.1 The Village agrees to pay COUNTY for the initial network, hardware and software installation costs, support, and maintenance services as described in this AGREEMENT based upon actual hours worked at the hourly rate of \$85 per hour plus cost of materials during normal business hours and \$127.00 per hour plus cost of materials for after hours support. COUNTY shall invoice the Village and provide an itemized statement listing the services provided and hours and dates on which such services were provided. The Village shall pay COUNTY within 30 days of receipt of the invoice from COUNTY.
- 1.2 Help Desk calls are billed in 5 minute increments. COUNTY shall invoice the Village bi-monthly for Help Desk calls. The Village shall pay COUNTY within 30 days of receipt of the invoice from COUNTY.
- 1.3 COUNTY shall invoice the Village annually, in the second - third quarter of any calendar year in which this AGREEMENT is effective, for the Village's share of COUNTY's fixed licensing and shared network fees based on the number of computers the Village has connected to the COUNTY's network. These fees may include but are not limited to Internet access, hardware and software license maintenance, firewall, and security device maintenance.

SECTION 4 -EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION

- 4.1 Upon approval by the Village and the COUNTY, this AGREEMENT shall become effective on _____.
- 4.2 This AGREEMENT shall automatically renew on January 1 of each calendar year unless a written notice of termination is provided by November 1 of the preceding year. Each renewal shall be in one-year increments.
- 4.3 Either party may terminate this AGREEMENT provided the terminating party gives 60 days prior written notice of its intent to terminate to the other party.
- 4.4 If an invoice for work made pursuant to Section 3 has not been paid 90 days after the date of the invoice, the COUNTY may terminate this agreement by providing written notice of termination to the Village. Such a termination does not affect the Village's duty to pay the outstanding invoice.

SECTION 5 - RESPONSIBILITY FOR DATA

- 5.1 The Village bears the sole responsibility for all data transmitted to or from and stored on Village computers or servers.

SECTION 6 - AMENDMENTS

- 6.1 This writing constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to all matters set forth herein. This agreement may be amended only in writing and signed by both parties. Any written amendments to this agreement shall be prospective in nature.

SECTION 7 - NOTICES

- 7.1 All notices, certificates, requests or other communications hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be given when receipt is acknowledged by certified mail, or delivered by personal service, addressed as follows:

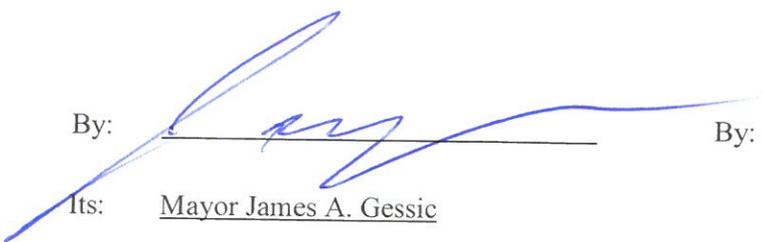

SECTION 8 - COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

- 1.1 Each party and its employees and subcontractors, if any, are independent contractors in relation to the other party with respect to all matters arising under this AGREEMENT. Nothing herein shall be deemed to establish a partnership, joint venture, association, or employment relationship between the parties. COUNTY shall be solely responsible for withholding and paying all wages, benefits, applicable taxes, workers' compensation, unemployment insurance, liability insurance, and all administrative costs for IT personnel.
- 1.2 All services provided by COUNTY through IT are performed on a non-discriminatory basis without regard to race, color, national origin, religion, age, marital status or handicap.
- 1.3 Both parties recognize the obligation of the other party to make its reports and other written materials available to the public upon request in accordance with the Ohio Public Records Act.
- 1.4 This AGREEMENT has been adopted by the parties and performance is in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, circulars, rules, and ordinances, including the requirements of the Ohio Open Meetings Act.
- 1.5 This AGREEMENT is entered into and enforceable in Lake County, Ohio and shall be governed by Ohio law. In the event that any portion of this AGREEMENT is deemed unlawful or otherwise unenforceable, it shall be stricken and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- 1.6 The parties agree that any action relating to this AGREEMENT shall be instituted and prosecuted in a court of competent jurisdiction in Lake County, Ohio and each party waives the right to a change of venue.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Lake County Automatic Data Processing Board and the VILLAGE OF PERRY have caused this AGREEMENT to be executed and to be effective as of the date set forth in Section 4.1 upon the execution and signature of the parties and in accordance with all statutes governing the authorization for and execution of this AGREEMENT.

Mayor and Members of Council,

June 25, 2025

Due to the lack of response from the consultant Perry Village has used for their primary information technology (IT) needs, and our need to move forward with establishing government emails, and to adequately protect against cyber-attacks and/or data breaches, I contacted the Lake County IT Department to obtain a quote for their services. The Lake County IT Department had to do a site assessment to ensure an accurate and adequate scope of work estimate was provided.

This site assessment was conducted on June 16, 2025 and on June 25, 2025 I received the assessment and related documents. Below is a summary of what the cost would be to contract with the county IT Department.

1. Firewall update to current standards- \$1080 (equipment only)
2. Firewall Install Labor -2 hours @\$85/hr. \$170
3. Two Switch update to current standard and secure cabinet \$875
4. Installation of switches \$340
5. Two new Dell computers for PD which can still be supported \$1684
6. Office 365 suite to enable government email for 8 users \$2342
7. Maintenance, License Fee, etc. for 10 computers \$1880
8. Integration into the county system \$1360

The total for the initial upfront cost would be approximately \$9578. Each subsequent year where no equipment upgrades were required, the annual reoccurring cost would be approximately \$4222 annually+ any calls into the support help desk.

Attached is the Scope of Work/Assessment of the current infrastructure, and detailed plan of upgrading and integrating into the County IT Dept. If we were to contract with the County IT Dept. it would enhance our cyber security significantly reducing our current vulnerabilities to potential cyber- attacks and data breaches. Also included are quotes for the equipment that would need to be purchased through the county. I would encourage each of you to review the attached documents in their entirety and seriously consider contracting with the County IT Department for our IT needs and cyber security.

For informational purposes the County IT Dept. provides services for the following entities outside of the county; Madison Township, Concord Township, Painesville City, Painesville Township, Lake County Development Authority, Lake County Visitor's Bureau, Lake County Airport, Timberlake, City of Willoughby Hills, City of Wickliffe, Waite Hill, Lake County Land Bank.

Thank you for the opportunity to work with Perry Village and its Information Technology (IT) needs. Per our previous discussions and visit, I am pleased to provide a proposal offering IT Services to Perry Village. By providing IT Services and integrating with the County network you can leverage our infrastructure for potentially reduced costs, reduce your dependence on external consultants and improved customer support. These are the components to the scope of work discussed:

1. Provide Information Technology Support Services.
2. Replacement and Upgrade of Firewalls and Server infrastructure.
3. Integration with the County network and infrastructure.

COMPONENT #1 SCOPE OF WORK: Provide Information Technology Support Services

- **Assessment**
 - Review and assess system architecture and equipment for efficiency, life expectancy, capacity, speed, and current business processes and make recommendations for improving support and maintenance.
- **Desktop Support**
 - Perform basic computer support functions including installation and repair of PC's, laptops, peripherals, and software. Support via Phone and email to our Helpdesk during normal business hours 8:00AM to 4:30PM. After hours call out list available.
- **Network and Server Support**
 - Management and support of network equipment, including switches, firewalls, routers and any other security devices.
 - Management and support of server systems, hardware, software, operating systems necessary for reliability and functionality of all systems.
 - Maintain all employee user and email accounts, add, change and removal.
 - Maintenance of virus detection systems on servers, workstations and laptops.
 - Manage and support data backup requirements.

- **Planning**
 - Engineering, planning, and design services for new systems, upgrades. Provide recommendations for future purchasing and technology needs when requested or necessary.

COMPONENT #2 SCOPE OF WORK: Replacement and Upgrade of Network and Server infrastructure.

- After reviewing the age and specifications of the current network switches (city hall/police department.) My recommendation would be to replace. I have attached a quote (*attachment-a.pdf*) for the recommended network switches. These new switches would support proper network segmentation to keep law enforcement traffic separate from other village network traffic as well as separate from wifi traffic.
 - One new switch for the central network closet.
 - One new switch for the garage area.
 - I would estimate up to 4 hours of labor billed at \$85/hour to set up the new switches.
 - Additionally on *attachment-a.pdf* I have included a network cabinet to properly lock up the equipment in the network/cleaning closet.
- Upon reviewing the current firewall the Village owns, my recommendation would be to replace. I have included this quote in *attachment-b.pdf*. The current Sonicwall firewall is considered end-of-life by the manufacturer, which could leave the Village vulnerable to network attacks. Our proposed replacement is a Sophos brand unit that the County standardizes on and would include three years of maintenance.
 - I would estimate 2 hours of labor billed at \$85/hour for this setup.
 - This would also go in the locking network cabinet quoted in *attachment-a.pdf*

COMPONENT #3 SCOPE OF WORK: Integration with the County Network

- The integration with the County will include the following processes:
 - Migration of data off gmail, and onto Office 365
 - This would have to be done manually and billed for the hours so recommended just for the users that use email frequently.
 - Any local computer data or google drive data moved to Onedrive
 - Purchase and setup a Domain (perryvillageohio.gov or similar) to County's management and registrar
 - A .org or similar could also be purchased.
 - Joining of PCs to County domain.
 - Computers would be connected to County Active Directory environment to facilitate logins and use of the County's security and management software stack to keep the computers and network safe.
 - Due to the age of two of the computers in the Police Department I would recommend replacement as they will not support Windows 11. Windows 10 is out of support in October of 2025. Our typical desktop with a 5 year warranty is *attachment-c.pdf*
 - Creation of necessary user accounts.
 - For this phase of work, I would estimate an additional up to 16 hours of labor billed at \$85/hour. This task is dependent on user roster.

COMPONENT #4 SCOPE OF WORK: Expanding services provided.

- **With the first three components completed further research and planning could be done to facilitate the following.**
 - Phone system replacement.
 - Perry Village currently utilizes a 3cx phone system managed by another vendor. With more information such as bills, phone number lists, and etc. A second scope of work could be developed to facilitate migrating to a County IT managed phone system.
 - When County IT did this for other customers there were significant cost savings.
 - Police MDTs connected to Lake County Sheriff Records.
 - Once the MDTs are under County IT's management connection to the Lake County Sheriff's records software could quickly and easily be setup.
 - Expansion of wireless coverage.
 - County IT would perform a coverage assessment at the Perry Village's current building and could recommend areas to increase wireless coverage.
 - Spectrum Internet cost savings.
 - There may be some cost savings available by switching the Village's current internet provider Spectrum, to the same Spectrum service on state term contract pricing.

Perry Village will be able to enjoy the following benefits by utilizing the County for IT Services and attaching to the County's network infrastructure:

1. Network security and authentication using the County's cohesive Active Directory
2. Advanced spam filtering and spyware protection
3. Virus protection for desktops and email
4. File and printer sharing between all County resources as they are needed
5. Content filtering for users accessing web sites
6. Sophisticated protection against intrusion from the Internet
7. Annual phishing test and security awareness training
8. Email archiving for public record requests
9. Ability to procure equipment at very competitive costs leveraging volume purchase agreements the County has already setup with Dell, Microsoft, CDWG, and other vendors
10. Help Desk and on-site support

TIMING AND FEES OF IMPLEMENTATION

All IT Services are provided on a Time & Materials contract whether in person or remote. IT Services, integration phases and Help Desk calls will be billed at an hourly rate of \$85/hour plus material. Help Desk calls are billed in 10 minute increments and invoiced quarterly. The Help Desk can be reach at 440-350-4444 or helpdesk@lakecountyohio.gov.

MAINTENANCE, SOFTWARE LICENSING, AND OTHER FIXED FEES

The IT Department annually charges all network users a prorated charge for licensing and shared resources that have fixed and predictable costs. These charges are issued in the second quarter of each year. Examples of these fixed costs include, but are not limited to, shared Internet access, server

hardware and software license maintenance, and firewall and security device maintenance. To summarize with an example, if the Village has 10 PCs connected to the County network, the County will issue a charge of $\$188 \times 10 = \1880 (using 2024's numbers). The total annual cost per connected PC was about \$188 for 2024.

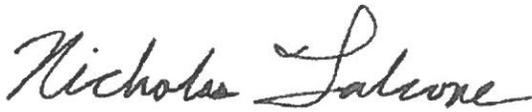
The other annual fee we charge is for Office 365 licensing. This cost for 2024 is \$292.80 per user / per year. This is the cost from Microsoft Lake County IT has to pass on. This Office 365 license grants each user the full Office suite on up to 5 devices, 100Gb Mailbox @perryvillageohio.gov, 1Tb of OneDrive space, access to Sharepoint, Teams, and more.

If Perry Village have users that do not need Office 365 or email, just standard user accounts could be created for computer use with no yearly charge.
