**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO HIRE
OFFICER MATTHEW MOORE AS A PATROLMAN
FOR THE PERRY VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Perry Police Department in order to provide proper oversight and staffing desires to make the following hiring:

1. Hire Matthew Moore as an Officer under the policies and procedures of the department.

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Village to adopt the same.

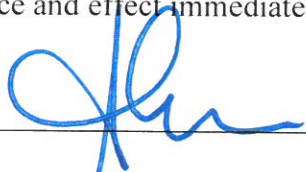
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That, the Village of Perry Council finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the Village of Perry to hire Officer Matthew Moore as a Patrolman, pending successful background check and under the policies and procedures of the Department.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

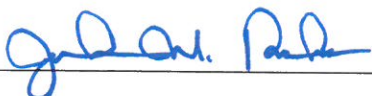
